1. The Michigan Moose Association shall conduct an annual bowling tournament on a handicap basis, sanctioned as a USBC moral support tournament. Only good standing members, in lodges in good standing in the Michigan Moose Association will be eligible.
2. The tournament shall be under the supervision of the Men's State Bowling Chairman. The Bowling Chairman shall hold office for as long as he does a good job. His duties will be to make up the schedules and entry blanks & mail them to each lodge, and team captain. To notify team captains as to times & dates to bowl. He shall make an application for a Tournament Sanction number. He shall send a final report to USBC. Entry blanks will be mailed to each lodge no later than September 15<sup>th</sup>. Reserved dates must have entries turned in no later than December 31<sup>st</sup>. Closing date will be determined by the Chairman. The Mich. Moose Association, Bowling Chairman, & the State Officers will take care of any other details that will make for a bigger and better Tournament.
3. USBC rules shall govern the tournament except for the specific rules which have been amended to the tournament. Any changes to the tournament, will be first turned in to the Moose State Sports Chairman to be approved by the Executive Board.
4. Entrants will use their highest Sanctioned League Ave based on a minimum of 21 games for the past season. If current ave. of 21 games or more is 10 pins higher than last year's ave. at time of bowling, this year's ave. must be used.  
If no ave. last year,  
**A=** Use highest current USBC sanctioned ave. of 21 games or more as of time of bowling. Summer ave.'s, not accepted.  
**B=** We will go back ( 3 ) year's on USBC averages.  
**C=** If entrant bowled in Moose Tournament in two of last three year's, he will use a tournament average.  
**D=** If no average is available, he will use a 170.
5. Handicap, will be 90 % of the difference between average and 240.
6. It shall be each bowlers responsibility to verify the accuracy of his ave. in hdcp. Tournaments, whether originally submitted by the bowler, his team captain or others. Failure to use the proper average shall disqualify score if

- submitted average is lower than actual average thereby resulting in more HDCP. Prize winnings shall be based on the submitted average if it is higher than the actual average. Corrections in averages can be made up to the completion of the first game of a series, or within 48 hours after the completion of a series if the Tourn. Chairman prior to the completion of the first game of the series, has given written consent to the bowler authorizing such extension of time to correct his average.
7. Substitutes will be furnished by the sponsoring lodge, unless a bowler from out of town can verify his average before bowling.
  8. Rule 319 A-B-C-D-E which covers average-reporting of prize winnings and possible average adjustment will be in effect and will be adhered to as specified in the USBC constitution of tournament rules.
  9. Entry fee shall be \$19.00 per event; \$8.50 prize fee; \$7.00 Bowling fee; \$3.50 expense fee, with an additional \$3.00 for All-Events. All-Events is optional. For a total of \$60.00 for all four events. Prize fee will be returned 100 % in cash and prizes. 5 % in each event will be paid for actual. All other prizes will be paid on a handicap basis.
  10. Jackets, shirts, or clocks will be awarded to first place in each event. In case of a tie, duplicate prizes will be awarded and prize money will be split.
  11. All tournament expense money not used in running the Tournament shall be known as surplus expense money, and used for starting the next year's tournament expenses. With donations to Moose Benefits.
  12. Prize list will be based on one out of every six entries in the team, doubles, & singles. One out of twelve in all-events. The first three places will be paid as follows:  
Team: 1<sup>st</sup> 15%; 2<sup>nd</sup> 10%; 3<sup>rd</sup> 7 1/2 %  
Doubles: 2/5 of five man prize  
Singles: 1/5 of five man prize  
Last place in each event equal to prize fee.
  13. USBC and non-USBC members may participate in this Moral Support Sanctioned Tournament with high score Recognition automatically extended to USBC members. Non-USBC members may qualify for high score recognition at their option by paying a \$21.00 fee for an unattached membership card.
  14. Bowler must sign release form, or he will not be allowed to bowl in the Men's State Bowling Tournament.
